Students must stay in the exam room for a **minimum of 1 hour**. Students have a **maximum of 2 hours** to write their exam (students have 2 ½ hours to write departmentals).

If a student is unable to write an exam on the scheduled date due to a significant reason, parents must contact the teacher **as soon as possible and prior to the exam. Departmental exams must be written on the set date & time.**

There are no regular classes for grade 10-12 students during exams so that students have time to prepare for all their exams. Students should come to school about 10-15 minutes before their exam starts and they are dismissed when they are finished writing their exam. . **If students have to remain at school** (eg. they ride the bus), **they need to speak with their teacher ahead of time to arrange a study location.** Busses run at usual times.
